March Block of the Month – Beyond Beginner - 12 ½ inches

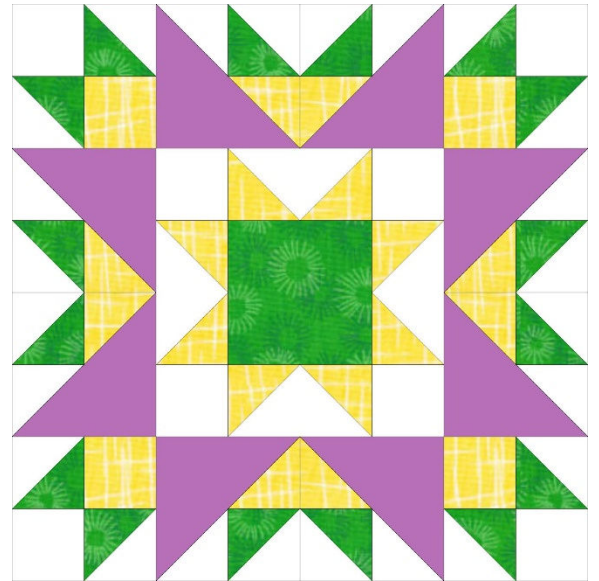
Cutting:

Purple: Four 3 7/8 inch squares, cut in half diagonally.

Green: One 3 ½ inch square, Eight 2 3/8 inch squares cut in half diagonally

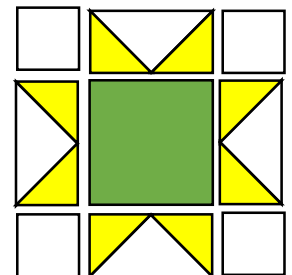
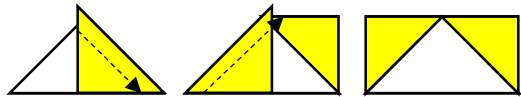
Yellow: Eight 2 3/8 inch squares cut in half diagonally, four 2 inch squares.

Background (white) - Twelve 2 3/8 inch squares cut in half diagonally, Eight 2 inch squares, one 4 ¼ inch square cut in half diagonally both ways.



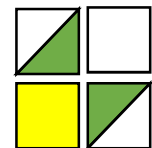
Sewing:

Sew center star by making four flying geese units from four large white triangles form 4 ¼ inch square and eight 2 3/8 inch yellow triangles. Sew a yellow triangle to each side of white triangle, matching points. Sew a 6 ½ inch variable star block with green 3 ½ inch square and white 2 inch squares.



Make 16 green/white half square triangles with 2 3/8 inch triangles.

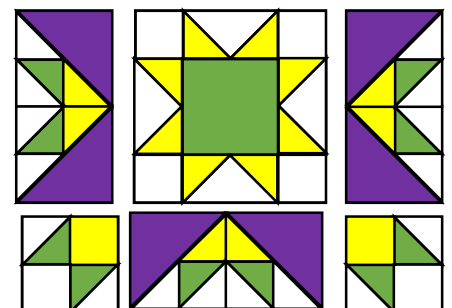
Use eight of these with white and yellow 2 inch squares to make four corner units:



Use remaining eight green/white squares to make half square units by sewing a yellow and white triangle to the sides of the green triangles. Half will have the yellow on the right, and the other half will have yellow on the left. Add 3 7/8 purple triangle to each one. To make a square. Sew pairs together to make outer star points



Arrange units as shown and sew together to complete block.
