

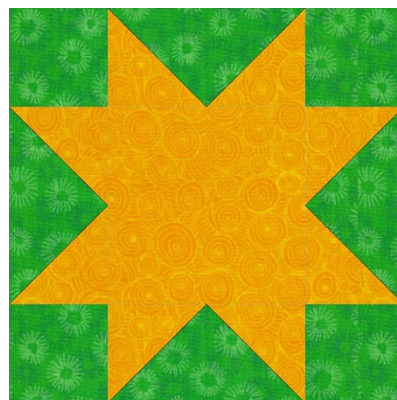
Variable Star

December Block of the Month – 12 ½ inches

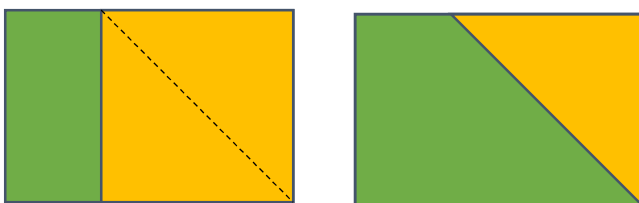
Colors – Christmas colors sound like fun for December!

Green or Red: Cut four 3 ½ inch squares and four 3 ½ x 6 ½ inch rectangles for the background.

Gold: Cut one 6 ½ inch square and eight 3 ½ inch squares for star.



Sewing: Sew four flying geese units from 3 ½ x 6 ½ rectangles and gold 3 ½ inch squares. Draw a diagonal line on the back of each of the gold 3 ½ inch squares. Place a gold square on one end of the background rectangle and sew on the marked line from corner to corner. Trim ¼ inch from seam and press out.

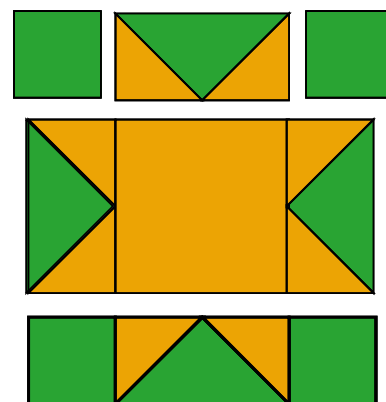


Add second corner in same manner, trim and press to complete Flying geese unit. Make four of these for your block.



Assemble flying geese with 3 ½ inch background squares and 6 ½ gold square as shown.

Tip: Sew with flying geese up so you can see the point. Stitch just a thread to the outside of the point to keep it looking sharp when pressed, and make sure to press seam away from the point (toward center of block.)
