

Square in a Square

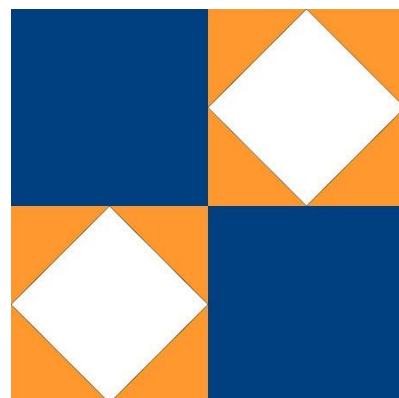
March Block of the Month – Beginner - 12 ½ inches

Cutting:

Dark Blue – Two 6 ½ inch squares

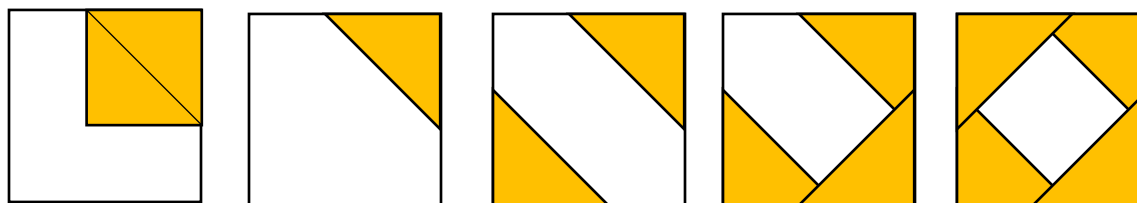
White – Two 6 ½ inch squares

Yellow – Eight 3 ½ inch squares



Sewing:

Finger press or lightly mark a diagonal line on the reverse side of each 3 ½ inch yellow square. Place a yellow square on one corner of the white square with the diagonal line going across the corner:



Sew a seam just to the outside of the line. Fold back the inside corner of the yellow square to make sure it covers the entire outside corner. If it looks good, trim and proceed to add a yellow square to each of the corners. Repeat with remaining white square and yellow triangles.

Assemble blocks in a four patch configuration. Watch your ¼ inch seam allowance so you don't cut off those points!
