



**BACKGROUND COLORS:** Any dark cool blues in prints, blenders, solids.

**KNOT COLORS:** Medium Blues with good contrast to the dark blue in prints, blenders, solids.

**CUTTING:** BACKGROUND fabric: three (3) patches - 2-1/2" square  
two (2) patches - 2-1/2" x 4-1/2"  
two (2) patches - 2-1/2" x 6-1/2"

KNOT fabric: four (4) patches - 2-1/2" square  
four (4) patches - 2-1/2" x 4-1/2"

1. It's easiest to lay the pieces out in the shape of the block before you start sewing.
2. Sew the 3 background 2-1/2" squares to 3 of the knot fabric 2-1/2" squares. Lay two of these pairings back into the corners of the layout pattern.
3. Sew the remaining knot fabric 2-1/2" square to one of the sets you just sewed so that the background fabric is in the center. Lay this 3-patch into the center of the layout.
4. Sew the two sets of A & B together. Press to the dark side.
5. Lay the two A/B sets back into the pattern pieces. Sew C to the top of the left hand set, and sew C to the bottom of the A/B set on the right side of the layout.
6. Make sure your pieces are laid out so the knot is as shown above, and then sew remaining pieces together. Enjoy that fine looking block you just made!
7. If you're feeling the joy of making, dig out more fun fabric and make another. ☺
8. For the Block Winners: To complete the pattern of the knot paths at the edge of the quilt top, add a 2-1/2" wide medium blue border. Then add another border in dark blue, 2-1/2" or wider.
