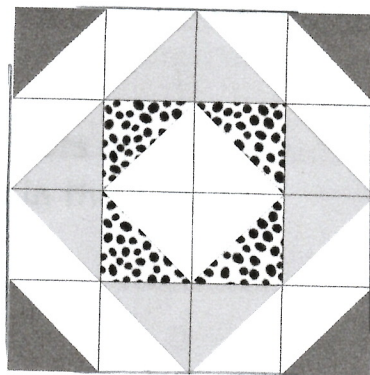
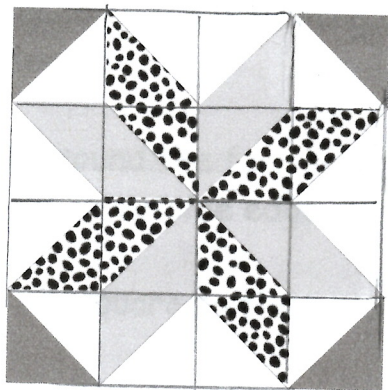
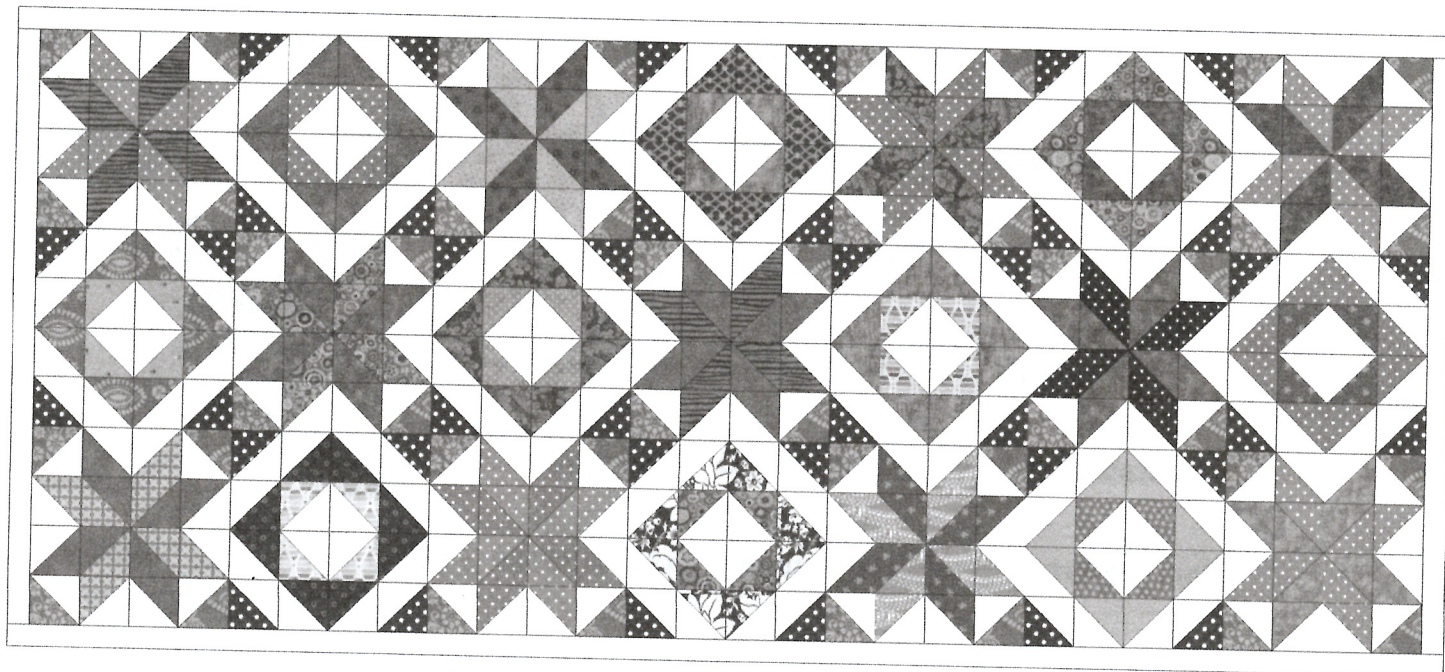


CSNS February 2024 BOM - LET'S GET FRISKY IN FEBRUARY !!!!!

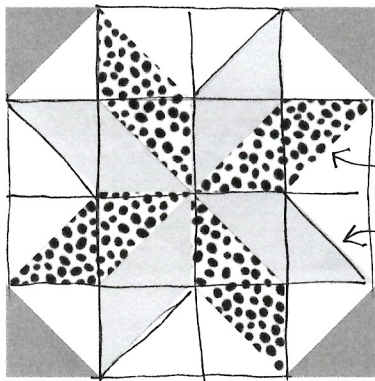


There's just two different blocks in this quilt design. No sashing needed, because the blocks make their own surprises. Let's have some fun with this! You can make either block, or, make both for two chances to win!

FUN SHORTCUTS: - We'll make all the HST's four-at-a-time.

COLORS - In honor of Valentines, let's use REDS, PINKS, FUSCHIA, MAGENTA, RED-ORANGE, HOT, HAPPY RED/PINK/ORANGE/WINE COLORS, dots, stripes, prints, solids, blenders, anything in hot bright red/pink colors. Have fun!!! Get Frisky with your color choices!!! Be silly, happy, and playful! To blend all the blocks together, please use a WHITE background.

**BLOCKS** - Each block needs 3 different color fabrics, and a white background. If you make both blocks, you can use the same color fabrics, or choose different colors plus white for the background. These blocks will be 12-1/2".





Color 1 - Cut one 5-3/4" square

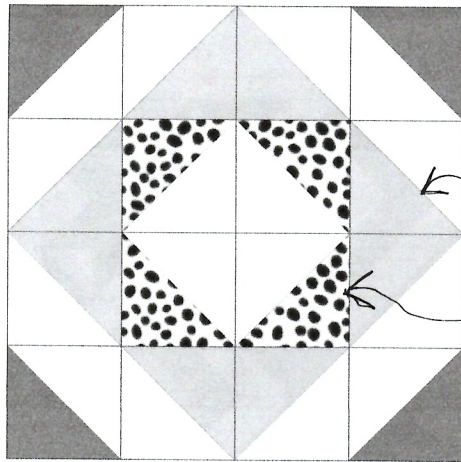
Color 2 - Cut two 5-3/4" squares

Color 3 - Cut two 5-3/4" squares

White - Cut three 5-3/4" squares

1. Layer one of the Color 2 patches with one of the Color 3 patches, right sides together.
2. Layer each of the remaining Color patches with a White patch, right sides together.
3. Sew all around the four sides of each of the sets of squares,  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the outside edge. (the dotted lines in the diagram). 
4. Iron each square to flatten and set the seams.
5. Cut diagonally from corner-to-corner both ways across the sewn patches in an X. 
6. Open the 4 HST's, and iron to the darker side.
7. **TRIM** all HST's to exactly 3-1/2". Do this by placing the diagonal line on your ruler exactly over the diagonal seam line in your block. Trim so that the tips of the diagonal seam fall exactly into the corners of your 3-1/2" block. This makes a perfect HST.
8. Lay out your trimmed patches to look like the diagram above, being careful to keep the diagonal seams turned in the right direction.
9. Sew this beauty together, and put it somewhere you can enjoy looking at it until the meeting!!!





Use 3 different color fabrics; 1 white:

Color 1 - Cut one 5-3/4" square

Color 2 - Cut two 5-3/4" squares

Color 3 - Cut one 5-3/4" square

White - Cut four 5-3/4" squares

1. We'll make all the HST's using the four-at-a-time trick. (12-1/2" block)
2. Layer each of the White squares with a Color square, right sides together.
3. Sew all around the four sides of the outside edge of each of the sets of squares,  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the outside edge. (the dotted lines in the diagram).
4. Iron each square to flatten and set the seams.
5. Cut diagonally across the sewn patches in an X.
6. Open the 4 HST's, and iron to the darker side.
7. TRIM all HST's to exactly 3-1/2". Do this by placing the diagonal line on your ruler exactly over the diagonal seam line in your block. Trim so that the tips of the diagonal seam fall exactly into the corners of your 3-1/2" block. This makes a perfect HST.
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
