

# Frayed Sawtooth Star

*December Block of the Month – Beyond Beginner - 12 ½ inches*

**Cutting:** Christmas Red, Green and Gold with white background

Green – One 18 x 2 inch strip

Red – One 18 x 2 inch strip

Gold - Four 3 7/8 inch squares

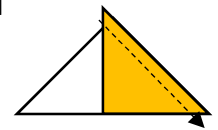
White: One 7 ¼ inch square, two 2 x 18 inch strips

**Sewing:**

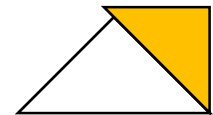
***Flying Geese:***

Use your background fabric square of 7 ¼ inches and the gold 3 7/8 inch squares to make these. Cut background square in half diagonally both ways to make four large triangles. Cut gold squares in half diagonally to make 8 small triangles.

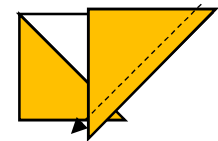
Sew small triangle to large triangle, lining up point. Sew with a ¼ inch seam



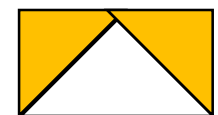
Press seam toward gold triangle



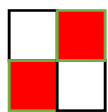
Sew a second gold triangle to the opposite side of background triangle with a ¼ inch seam.



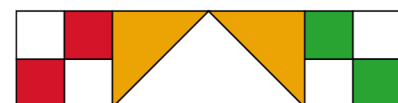
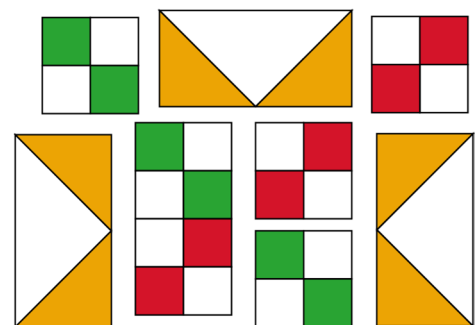
Press seam toward gold triangle. Trim off dog ears.



Sew green and red strips to a background strip. Cut each of these strips into eight 2 inch sections. Sew sections in pairs to make four 4 patch units of each color.



Sew two red and two green 4 patches to make the center square. Assemble block as illustrated.
