*February Block of the Month – Beyond Beginner - 12
½ inches*

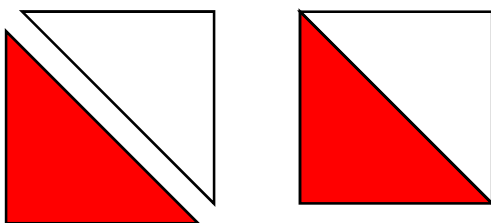
Cutting: Reds and Low Volume prints for background

Red – Twenty 2 ½ inch squares, Five 2 7/8 inch squares cut in half diagonally to make 10 Triangles. (To make cutting your squares quicker, cut five 5 inch squares of red, then cut in half both ways to make 4 squares of each.)

Background – Six 2 ½ inch squares, Five 2 7/8 inch squares cut in half diagonally to make 10 Triangles.

Sewing:

Sew 10 half square triangles using Red and Background triangles. Press seams toward red.




Referring to picture of block, sew in rows (each row will have a total of 6 squares), alternating pressing seam allowances to opposite sides.



What is a Low Volume Print? Low volume fabrics can be described as basically subtle white, cream, neutral or pale colored print fabrics often with a delicate self-colored pattern or subtle design and they are selected to offset the much brighter palette of colors available in many fabric lines. Think of pale floral designs, faint spots or those white fabrics with text and these would be described as low volume – your eye sees them as soft colors even though they are not entirely plain. Low volume fabrics won't 'fight' with more colorful fabrics and will let those bright prints shine!
