

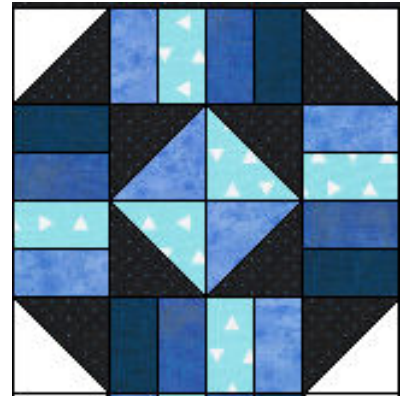
Crossroads

January Block of the Month – 12 ½ inches

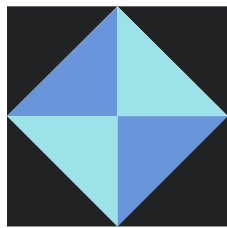
Colors – Blues from light to dark, four strips 2 x 16 inches

Squares for Half Square Triangles – Four Dark Blue, One Medium Blue and One light Blue at 3 7/8 inches. Cut in half diagonally

Background – White: Two squares 3 7/8 for half square triangles.



Sewing: Use four dark blue triangles and four white triangles to make the four half square triangle units for the corners of the block. Press the seams to the Dark blue. Make two half



square triangles with dark blue and medium blue, pressing seams toward the medium blue; and two with dark blue and light blue, pressing the seams toward the dark blue.

Sew the two triangles with medium blue and the two with light blue together to make the center square. Take care to match the points at the edges of this section.

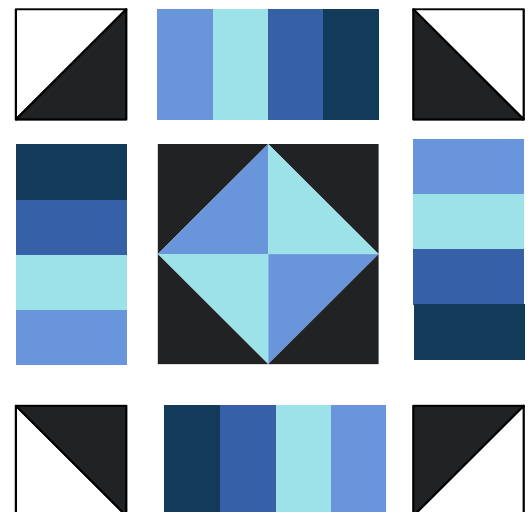
For strip section of block, sew all four strips together in desired order (you choose!) Your finished strip should measure 6 ½ inches wide.



After your strips are sewn, cut into four 3 ½ x 6 ½ inch sections.



Sew a white and dark blue half square triangle to each end of two strip pieced units. Sew a strip unit to each side of the center pieced unit. Sew these pieced units together as illustrated.
