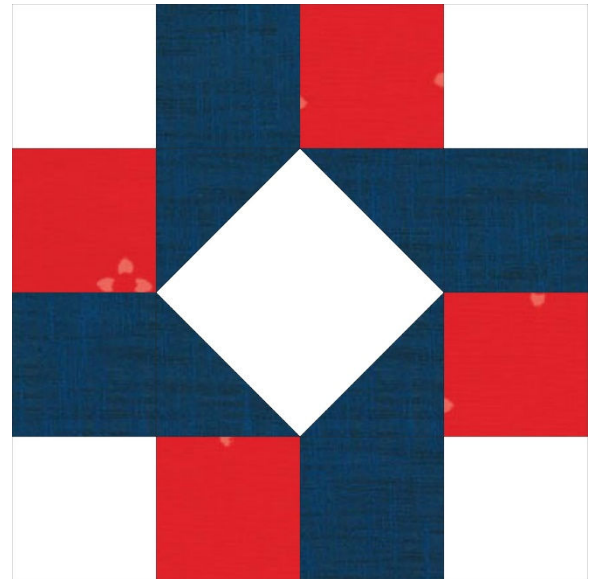
June Block of the Month – Beginner - 12 ½ inches

Cutting: Red White and Blue!

Red: Four 3 ½ inch squares.

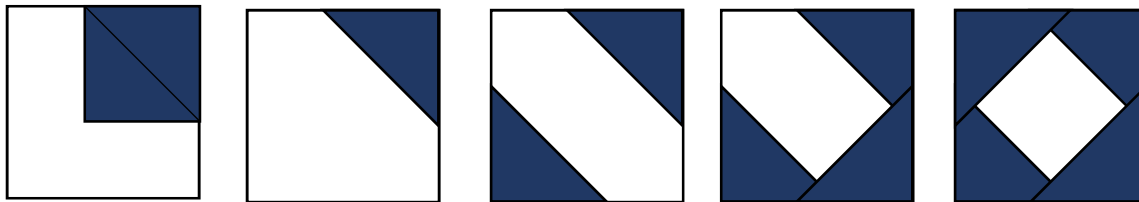
Blue: Eight 3 ½ inch squares.

White: One 6 ½ inch square, four 3 ½ inch squares.



Sewing:

Make a Diamond in a square unit with the 6 ½ inch white square and four blue squares: Finger press or lightly mark a diagonal line on the reverse side of each 3 ½ inch blue square. Place a blue square on one corner of the white square with the diagonal line going across the corner:



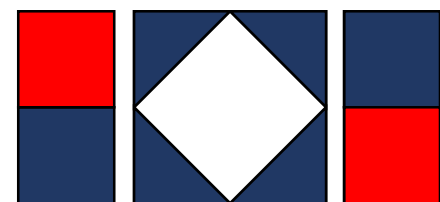
Sew a seam just to the outside of the line. Fold back the inside corner of the blue square to make sure it covers the entire outside corner. If it looks good, trim and proceed to add a blue square to each of the corners.



Sew Red squares to blue squares, press seams toward blue.

Add a White square to each end of two of these, press seams toward blue and red squares. Sew to sides of diamond in a square unit, pressing seams toward squares.

Note how the blue square is placed to give this block its twisting appearance – it's a little tricky, but important to make the block look right!
