March Block of the Month – Beyond Beginner - 12 ½ inches

Cutting:

Yellow: Four 4 ½ inch squares, four 2 ½ x 4 ½ inch rectangles

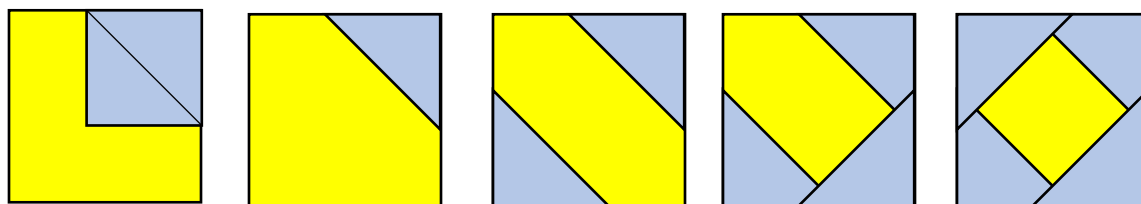
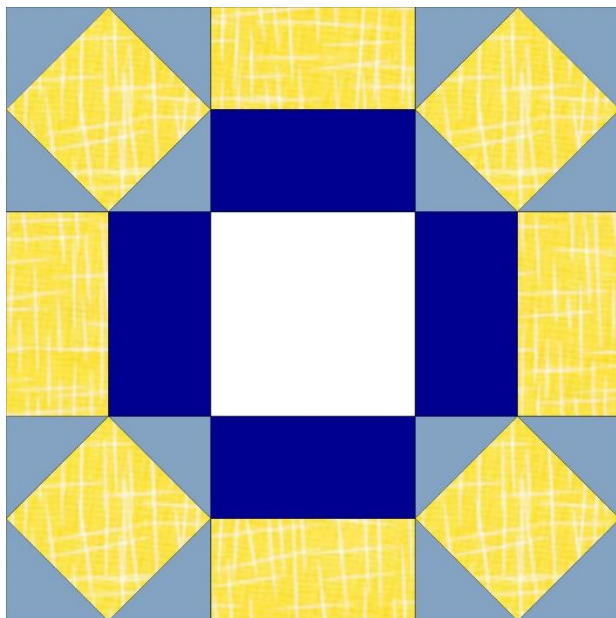
Light Blue – Sixteen 2 ½ inch squares

Dark Blue – Four 2 ½ x 4 ½ inch rectangles

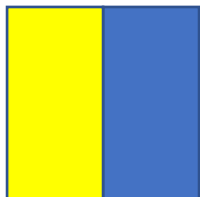
Background – One 4 ½ inch square

Sewing:

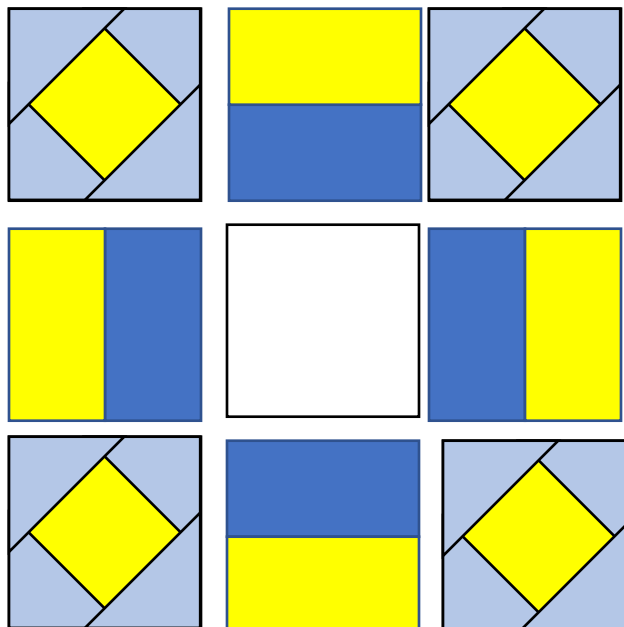
Draw or finger press a diagonal line on the reverse of all 16 2 ½ inch light blue squares. Place a light blue square on one corner of a 4 ½ yellow square with the diagonal line running across the corner. Stitch just to the outside of the line, fold back your inside corner to cover your outside corner. If this looks good, trim ¼ inch from the seam and proceed by sewing a light blue square to the rest of the corners. Complete all four yellow and blue squares in this manner.



Sew yellow rectangles to dark blue rectangles:



Sew all units together as illustrated – watch your ¼ inch seam allowance, and match the points with the seams in the rectangles:
