May Block of the Month – Beyond Beginner - 12 ½ inches

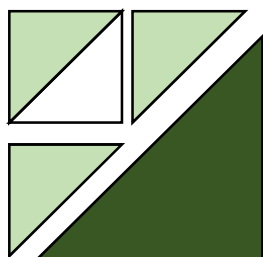
Cutting: Your choice of colors in light, medium and dark shades!

Dark: One 6 7/8 square cut in half diagonally, One 3 7/8 inch square cut in half diagonally

Medium: Two 3 ½ squares, six 3 7/8 inch squares cut in half diagonally

Light: Three 3 7/8 inch squares, cut in half diagonally.

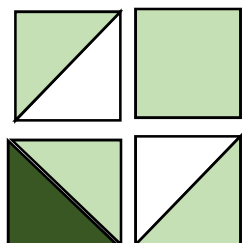
Sewing:



We are going to start by making two of the triangle units from last month – don't worry they are much easier at this size! Make two half square triangles using medium and light half square triangles (press seam toward medium triangle). Sew a medium half square triangle to each side to create a triangle. Sew each of these triangles to a dark 6 7/8 inch triangle to finish your squares, which will be the ends of your spools (press seam toward dark triangle).

*don't forget to trim the dog ears!

For the sides of your spools, sew four medium/light half square triangles and two medium dark half square triangles using remaining triangle pieces (press all seams toward medium triangles). Sew together as illustrated.



Assemble your units as shown and you will have your finished block!

(Definitely not as challenging as April's block – have fun!)
