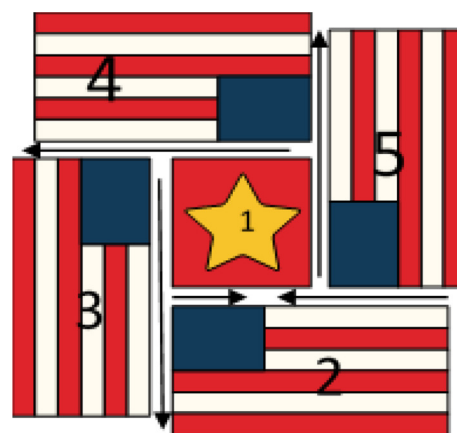
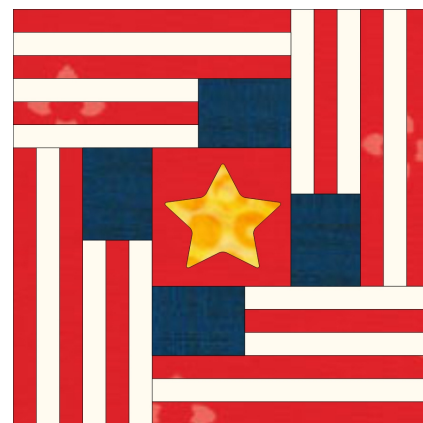
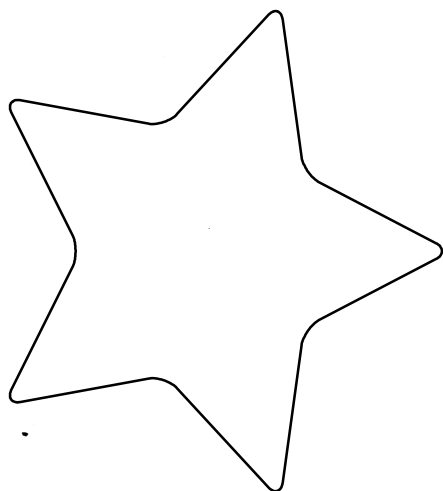


April 2020 Challenge Block

Coos Sand 'n Sea Quilters BOM - June 2012 "Grand Old Flag"



Fabric needed:

Red: Two 1" x 27" strips, one 1" x 19" strip,
one 3 1/2" square for center.

White: One 1" x 27 inch strip, Two 1" x 19" strips

Four pieces of 2" x 2-1/2" squares of Blue for Flag

3" square of Gold for big star on Red background + Fusible web for Star

Directions:

1. Join 1" x 26" each Red strip, a White strip and a Red strip and press to the Red, (cut 4 6-1/2" segments)
2. Join 1" x 18" each White strip, Red strip and White strip and press to the Red (cut 4 4-1/2" segments)
3. Sew the 2" x 2-1/2" Blue to the 4 short WRW segments (per diagram)
4. Sew the 4 long RWR segments to the 4 previous segments (per diagram) (this segment will finish to 6-1/2" x 3-1/2" which = 4 Flags)
5. Trace star pattern onto fusible web, cut out and fuse to 3-1/2" Red square
6. Next will be joining the 5 segments together and this part is VERY important:

Lay the Gold Star segment next to one Flag segment, next to the Blue (per picture)

Start sewing seam, stopping about 1-1/2" from edge of Gold Star segment

Take second Flag segment and lay next to first Flag segment and Gold Star

Segment and sew from one end to the other. Press seam to Star.

Take the third Flag segment and repeat. Press seam to Star.

Take the fourth Flag segment and repeat to Star.

Now, go back and sew seam of first Flag segment to the fourth Flag segment.

Finish pressing seam to Star and you're done!!
