

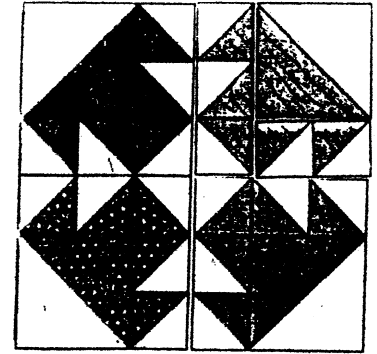

Challenge Block



*Coos Sand 'n Sea Quilt BOM*  
**December 2013 Double T**

Originally presented by:

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**DoubleT**

For a 12" finished block, cut:

Background fabric - off white, cream

Cut 2 - 5" x 5" squares, cut in half diagonally

Cut 12 - 3" x 3" squares

Fabric - scrappy choose a different color for each T!

From EACH color or print:

Cut 1 - 5" x 5" square, cut in half diagonally

Cut 3 - 3" x 3" squares

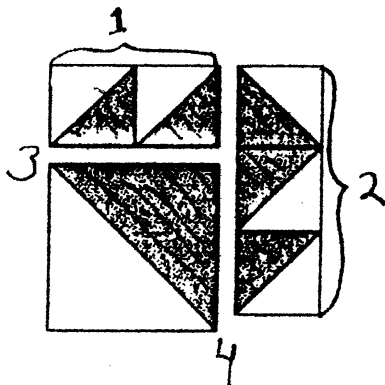
Match the 3" squares of print with the 3" squares of background, right sides together. Draw a line down the center, diagonally, and sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the line and cut apart and press open. Square up to be a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Sew the background triangle (from the 5x5 square) to one print triangle (from the 5x5 square). Press open and square up to a  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " block. (you will have one print triangle left over of each print, these are not used)

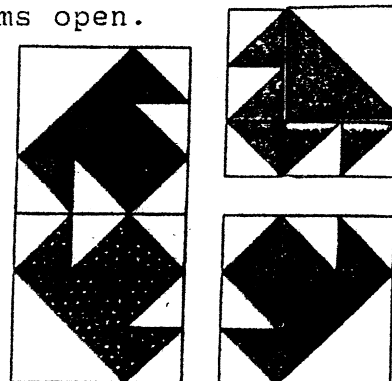
Then sew the units together as shown below:

Assembly Diagram:

Sew in order:



Press seams open.



Arrange color order to your choosing.
