# P.D.Q. BAG

Finished Size: 15" x 14 1/2"

## YOU WILL NEED:

- (1) 1/2 yard outside fabric and handles
- (1) 1/2 yard lining fabric
- (1) 15" x 32" Shape Flex 101 or Fusible Fleece

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

### Outside Fabric

1. Cut (1) 15" x 32" outside fabric.
2. Cut (1) 3" x WOF for handles.

### Lining Fabric

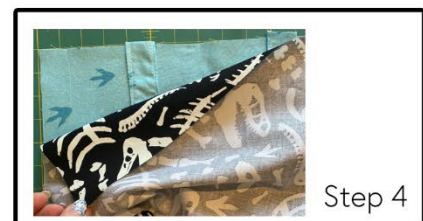
1. Cut (1) 15" x 28" lining fabric.

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

1. All seams are 1/4".
2. Fold handle strip in half, with wrong sides together, making it 1 1/2" x WOF, and sew 1/4" seam. Turn right side out and press. Lengthen stitch and top stitch 1/8" - 1/4" on each side. Trim handle to (2) 21" pieces.



3. Press Shape Flex 101 or fusible fleece to outside fabric.
4. Place outside fabric right side up. On the 15" side, place handle 4" from each edge, lining up the raw edges. Place lining fabric on top, with the right side facing down. Sew 1/4" seam, securing handles between outside and lining fabrics.



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5. Repeat on opposite end with the 15" side, securing second handle between outside and lining fabrics.
6. Secure handles with a clip to prevent them being sewn into side seams.
7. With wrong sides together, place the (2) 15" seams on top of each other. Sew the length of one side. On the second side, leave a 3" gap in the lining piece to turn bag right side out.
8. Turn the bag right side out, using 3" gap. Sew gap closed.
9. Push lining into the bag. The outside fabric is longer than the lining and will roll into the inside of the bag. Press the top of the bag. Lengthen stitch and sew around the top of the bag, securing handles on the inside of the bag. Sew around the top of the bag again about 1/2" from the top.
10. Enjoy your PDQ bag!
