

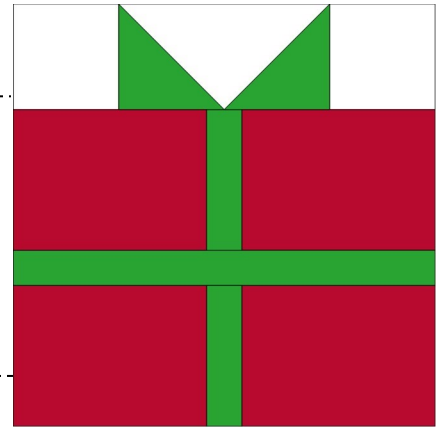

Christmas Gift Block

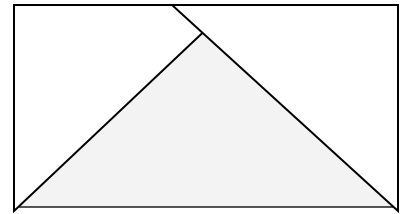
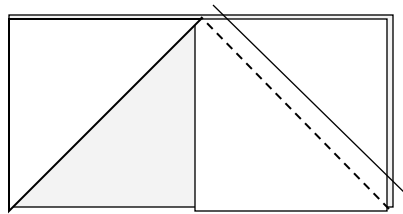
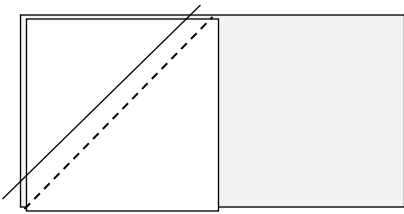
CUTTING

Fabric:	Background	Gift	Ribbon & Bow
	2 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "	4 - $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6"	2 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "
	1 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ "		1 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ "
			2 - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ "



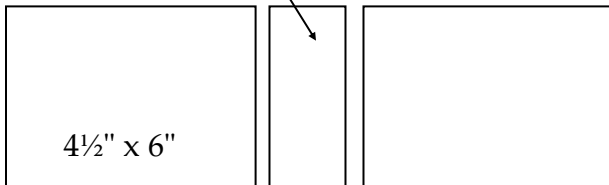
SEWING

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " bow squares.
2. Layer a bow square with the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " background fabric, stitch on the line. Trim excess fabric to $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press toward the background fabric. Repeat for the other side to make one flying goose block measuring $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".
3. Stitch a $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " background square to either side of the flying goose. Press to the background fabric.



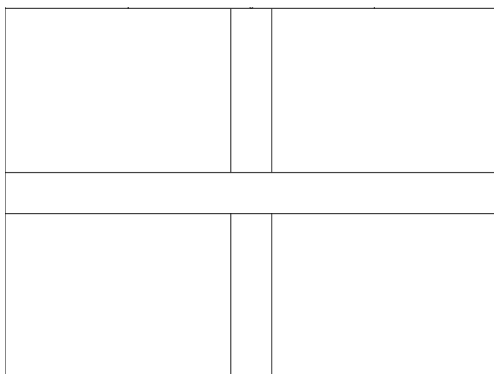
4. Stitch the block together following the diagrams below.

$1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "



Press Seams to the ribbon fabric. Make 2 units.

Stitch the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Ribbon fabric between the 2 units made in the previous step. Press Seams to the ribbon fabric.



Stitch the bow unit made in step 3 to the top of the gift. Press Seam to the gift.
