A 4" sleeve must be securely sewn to the top/back of each large quilt (hung on a rack), or a 2 1/2" sleeve on small quilts (wall hangings). For detailed instructions on quilt sleeves, go to <https://www.americanquilter.com/quiltweek/aqs-quilt-contests/hanging-sleeve-instructions> Also, know that if your entry is more than 96", it will be folded to accommodate our racks.

Every effort is made to take excellent care of your entry. Your homeowner's insurance is expected to cover your quilt in case of loss or damage, but check with your agent to be certain.
